

2020–2021 DANCE FUSION STUDIO POLICIES

All classes will start this year on Monday September 14th 2020.
Our year will end with our scheduled Recital on Sunday June 20th 2020.

GENERAL STUDIO POLICIES:

1. Students must have proper dance attire in each class. Hair must be tied back securely and no jewelry is allowed. Students will be asked to leave the class if not dressed appropriately. Please refer to our Studio Dress Code for suitable attire for each class.
2. No student is to leave the classroom without permission.
3. No gum is permitted in the studio whatsoever.
4. Only water in bottles are permitted in the dance studios during classes. Other food and drinks are restricted to the waiting area and kitchen only. Please help keep our studio tidy and clean up after yourself.
5. Please do not interrupt a class in progress. Parents are not permitted in the studios during classes. Please speak to someone at the desk or the office if you have questions.

NEW COVID-19 POLICIES: With the ever changing preventative measures and business policies surrounding COVID-19 we have to implement new guidelines to help keep all of our dancers, staff and families safe at the studio. These guidelines will continue to be adapted and modified to meet the requirements of our local health unit and the provincial guidelines.

1. Registration for all classes must be done online through our website. Dancers may not start class until Registration is completed and our new COVID-19 waiver has been signed online.
2. Masks must be worn by anyone over the age of 3 upon entry to our facility. Dancers are able to remove their masks for class but they must be worn in all common areas.
3. Our changerooms are temporarily closed to help us maintain physical distancing, so please bring your dancer dressed and ready for class.
4. All shoes must be removed at the front door upon entry. This includes dancers in our Hip Hop classes, as indoor running shoes must be brought for these classes.
5. Hand sanitizer will be supplied at the front door for everybody upon entry. It will also be supplied at each studio for dancers to use before and after class.
6. If your dancer is feeling sick please do not bring them to the studio.
7. Plan to arrive at the studio only 5-10 minutes before your dancer's class to help us stay under the limitations of patrons in our facility.
8. Social distancing markers will be used at our front desk, outside of each studio and in our dance studios. Please help us all maintain proper social distancing in our facility.
9. Dancers under the age of 6 may have 1 parent bring them to the studio. No other family members or large groups please.
10. In the case of another provincial mandatory shut-down our class schedule will move immediately to Zoom classes for the remainder of that month only. Following the end of that month we will stop all regular monthly charges to credit cards and reassess class options.
11. If you have travelled outside of Canada you may not enter our facility for two weeks.
12. If any one of our dancers, staff or patrons tests positive for COVID-19 we will immediately contact all affected families as per required by the province. At that point we will follow the direction of our local health unit on the next steps.

2020–2021 DANCE FUSION STUDIO POLICIES

CLASS FEES & SCHEDULING:

Monthly class fees for the 2020-2021 season is based on 32 classes in a 10 month dance year. Monthly class fee includes monthly tuition and a Recital costume for that class. All holidays and studio closures are already taken into account.

- 1 hour class = \$78.00 + HST
- 45 minute class (3-4 year old Core Classes) = \$68.00 + HST

****10% discount for 2nd child in a family. 25% discount for third child in a family.*

PAYMENT POLICIES:

1. Upon Registration there is a \$30.00 non-refundable Family Registration & Insurance Fee.
2. Dance Fusion must have a credit card on file for monthly tuition payments.
3. Monthly tuition will be charged to the credit card on file at the 1st of each month. If you do not wish to have your card charged then a tuition payment must be made to the studio prior to the 1st of the month. Payment is accepted via e-transfer, or by cash, debit and credit card at the front desk.
4. For students wishing to discontinue classes, the front desk must be notified before the 1st of the month and then there will be no further credit card charges.
5. Paid fees are non-refundable.
6. If your card on file cannot be charged, and subsequently your payment is late then a 10% late fee per week will be applied to your account.
7. There are no longer credit card service fees associated with monthly tuition.

RECITAL & COSTUME POLICIES:

1. Dance Fusion's Year End Recital is scheduled for Sunday June 20th 2021, at the P.C. Ho Theatre in Scarborough. We encourage all dancers to finish the year and participate in this spectacular show.
2. Each child will have 1 Recital dance and costume per class that they take.
3. Costume Fees are included with monthly tuition and there are no extra costume fees .
4. Parents will need to purchase tickets at the end of the year for the Recital.
5. All family accounts must be paid in full before a child can participate in our Recital.

MISSED CLASSES: Everybody misses classes for one reason or another. If you do miss a class we can offer you an alternative during the week if one is available. There are no refunds for missed classes.

CLASS CANCELLATIONS: The studio reserves the right to cancel classes due to inclement weather or other emergencies. Please call the studio after 3:00pm and listen to the message on the machine if there is a question regarding class cancellation and an email will be sent out.
