

## **2021–2022 DANCE FUSION STUDIO POLICIES**

All classes will start this year on Monday September 13th 2021.  
Our year will end with our scheduled Recital on Sunday June 19th 2022.

### ***GENERAL STUDIO POLICIES:***

1. Students must have proper dance attire in each class. Hair must be tied back securely and no jewelry is allowed. Students will be asked to leave the class if not dressed appropriately. Please refer to our Studio Dress Code for suitable attire for each class.
2. No student is to leave the classroom without permission.
3. No gum is permitted in the studio whatsoever.
4. Only water in bottles are permitted in the dance studios during classes. Other food and drinks are restricted to the kitchen only. Please help keep our studio tidy and clean up after yourself.
5. Please do not interrupt a class in progress. Parents are not permitted in the studios during classes. Please speak to someone at the desk or the office if you have questions.
6. The studio, our facilities and our staff are to be respected at all times.

***COVID AND HEALTH & SAFETY POLICIES:*** With the ever changing preventative measures and business policies surrounding COVID, we have implemented guidelines to help keep all of our dancers, staff and families safe at the studio. These guidelines will continue to be adapted and modified to meet the requirements of our local health unit and the provincial guidelines. These may change prior to classes starting again in September and so you will be updated if necessary.

1. Registration for all classes must be done online through our website. Dancers may not start class until Registration is completed and our new waiver has been signed online.
2. Masks must be worn upon entry to our facility. Dancers are able to remove their masks for class but they must be worn in all common areas.
3. All shoes must be removed at the front door upon entry. This includes dancers in our Hip Hop classes, as indoor running shoes must be brought for these classes.
4. Hand sanitizer will be supplied at the front door for everybody upon entry. It will also be supplied at each studio for dancers to use before and after class.
5. If your dancer is feeling sick please do not bring them to the studio. If a dancer feels ill during class, they will be immediately taken to the office and isolated. If a parent is not in the building at the time we will contact you to come pick up your dancer.
6. Plan to arrive at the studio only 5-10 minutes before your dancer's class to help us stay under the limitations of patrons in our facility.
7. Social distancing markers will be used at our front desk, outside of each studio and in our dance studios. Please help us all maintain proper social distancing in our facility.
8. In the case of another provincial mandatory shut-down our class schedule will move immediately to Zoom classes for the remainder of that month only. Following the end of that month we will stop all regular classes and reassess as necessary.
9. If any one of our dancers, staff or patrons tests positive for COVID we will immediately contact all affected families as per required by the province. At that point we will follow the direction of our local health unit on the next steps.

## **2021–2022 DANCE FUSION STUDIO POLICIES**

### **CLASS FEES & SCHEDULING:**

Annual class fees for the 2021-2022 season is based on 32 classes in a 10 month dance year.

\*Class fees include tuition and a Recital costume for that class.

\*Payment is due on the 10th of each month, September-June.

- *1 hour class + Recital costume = 10 equal payments of \$78.00 + HST*
- *45 minute class + Recital costume = 10 equal payments \$68.00 + HST*

*10% discount for 2nd child in a family, 25% discount for third child in a family.*

### **PAYMENT POLICIES:**

1. Upon Registration there is a \$30 non-refundable Family Registration & Insurance Fee due.
2. Dance Fusion must have a credit card on file for tuition payments.
3. Equal payments will be charged to your credit card on file on the 10th of each month, September-June. If you do not wish to have your card charged then a tuition payment must be made to the studio prior to the 10th of that month. Payment is accepted via e-transfer, cash, or debit and credit card at the front desk.
4. For students wishing to discontinue classes, the front desk must be notified before the 10th of the month and then there will be no further credit card charges.
5. Paid fees are non-refundable.
6. If your card on file cannot be charged, and subsequently your payment is late then a 10% late fee per week will be applied to your account.
7. There are no longer credit card service fees associated with monthly tuition.

### **RECITAL & COSTUME POLICIES:**

1. Dance Fusion's Year End Recital is scheduled for Sunday June 19th 2022, at the P.C. Ho Theatre in Scarborough. We encourage all dancers to finish the year and participate in this spectacular show.
2. Each child will have 1 Recital dance and costume per class provided that they can keep.
3. Costume Fees are included with monthly tuition and there are NO extra costume fees .
4. Parents do need to purchase tickets at the end of the year for the Recital.
5. All family accounts must be paid in full before a child can participate in our Recital.

**MISSED CLASSES:** Everybody misses classes for one reason or another. If you do miss a class we can offer you an alternative during the week, if one is available. There are no refunds for missed classes.

**CLASS CANCELLATIONS:** The studio reserves the right to cancel classes due to inclement weather or other emergencies. Please call the studio after 3:00pm and listen to the message on the machine if there is a question regarding class cancellation and an email will be sent out.
