

SEPTEMBER 2020 CLASS SAFETY MEASURES & STUDIO PROTOCOLS

The health and safety of our dancers, staff and families is our top priority this month.

The follow protocols are to be followed at Dance Fusion for September 2020 in compliance with the guidelines set and approved by our local public health unit.

Updates and changes will be made in the months ahead as we continue to offer you a safe and awesome return to dance!



*Masks must be worn by anyone over the age of 2 entering the building. Masks are not required to be worn by dancers during class, but they are required in all common areas.

*All shoes must be removed in the main lobby entrance and placed on the stationed shoe racks. Even for our Hip Hop classes, dancers must bring indoor running shoes only for class with them.

*Our front lobby has been divided into separate entrance and exit sides by the shoe racks. Please respect and follow the arrows to help keep traffic moving in the lobby.

*Upon entry into the building there is hand sanitizer provided at the front desk for everyone.

*We have designated social distancing markers at the front desk for any parent who needs to come in to finalize registration, make a payment or speak to a staff member.

*We ask that parents limit coming into the building so that we can manage our numbers inside.

*We have designated a safe drop-off and pick-up area outside the front door for our older dancers to use.

*Any dancer 6 & under can have 1 parent accompany them into the studio and help them find their class. No extra family members, thank you.

*Plan to arrive only 5-10 minutes early for your class.

*Changerooms are temporarily closed to dancers so plan to arrive dressed and ready for class.

*Dancers will still have access to our washrooms, that now have enhanced cleaning protocols each day.

*We encourage dancers to use the washroom before class so that they can remain in the studio for the duration of their class.

*Any dancer requiring help from a parent using the washroom needs to do so before class.

*NO food is allowed in the building right now.

*Kitchen access is only open for dancers to refill their water bottles if needed.

*Limited lobby seating is available for 1 parent waiting for a younger dancer during class. Masks must be worn at all times and physical distancing practised.

*Teachers will let dancers into their studio when they are ready for class and provide them with hand sanitizer at the door.

*Dancers may take a dance bag and a water bottle only into the studio with them.

*Once in the studio dancers may remove their masks for class if they choose. Masks can then be stored in their dance bag.

*Dancers will use markers for their bags in the studios that are physically distanced from each other.

*Each studio has a grid taped on the floors to help dancers establish and maintain physical distancing throughout class.

*At the end of class dancers will be dismissed with physical distancing in mind and be provided with more hand sanitizer.

*Dancers will be encouraged to gather their belongings in preparation to head directly to the lobby to exit the building.

*We ask that parents wait outside for their dancer, weather permitting to help us keep our lobby safe and clear for the next set of dancers arriving..
